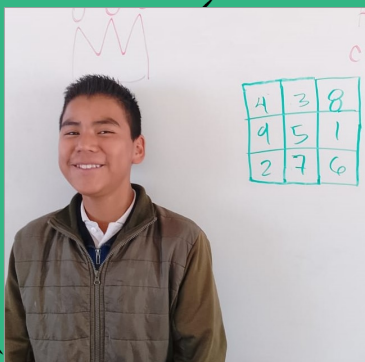


Above left: Kids love kicking the ball around. Above right: Andrea won a girls soccer competition and Luis with his 2nd place medal.

Left: Luis (blue shirt) competes and wins second place in the 800 meter obstacle course, representing the municipality. Next, he will compete representing the State of Chihuahua.



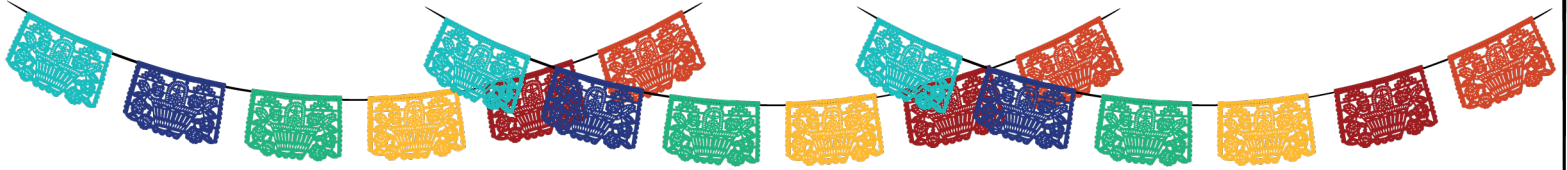
